PRESIDENT'S REMARKS

Welcome to the 2020 Annual Meeting of the Marblehead Museum and thank you for your support and for being a member.

As we pass the first anniversary of this global health crisis, I am aware that over the last year, many organizations (and the people behind them) have taken on heightened roles for the benefit of everyone in their communities. Marblehead Museum has exemplified this effort by extending itself well beyond its original mission of preserving and protecting the past. In the words of the Smithsonian's current CEO, Lonnie Bunch, "Museums become better places when they recognize that they can't be community centers, but they could be at the center of their communities."

This sentiment is actively personified by my predecessor, Jack Attridge, who for the last 10 years, served as President of the Marblehead Museum. It is due to Jack's efforts, leadership and guidance (especially his attention to membership income and the annual appeal) that the Museum was able to withstand the operational and financial stressors of 2020. In addition, we are grateful for the outstanding supervision of our

endowment by Alex Case (who took over the chairmanship of this committee from TJ Fitzgerald) and the endowment committee. Precise budget management kept us from dipping into our endowment funds during 2020. In turn, the Museum will begin 2021 in strong financial standing.

From the start of our state-mandated quarantine early last spring, the Marblehead Museum deftly adapted to a new normal in large part thanks to our outstanding Executive Director, Lauren McCormack. Lauren responded quickly to early indicators regarding the potential spread of COVID-19. She worked tirelessly to keep staff and volunteers safe while simultaneously moving the Museum's spring calendar of events to an online platform.

This shift could not have happened so swiftly and so flawlessly without the help of Amy Durbin, Assistant Director. In only a matter of days, the Museum was up and running with virtual programing, bringing exceptional workshops and lectures into the comfort of living rooms in Marblehead and as far away as Italy. Certainly, if I had to recognize a silver lining to the pandemic, it is that technology has allowed the Museum's offerings to be enjoyed by a wider and more diverse audience.

In addition, Amy spearheaded a social media and newsletter strategy to share educational, upbeat and entertaining content with our members. The goal of all communication from the Museum is to provide meaningful connection to our beloved community, especially during this difficult time of social restrictions.

Once Massachusetts reached Phase III of re-opening, Lauren and her staff developed a state-approved procedure that allowed for limited-size tours of the Lee Mansion. These took place throughout the summer and continued until the end of October and were very well received by attendees.

Starting in the late spring, in an effort to support the town by providing outdoor space for gatherings, the Marblehead Museum offered discount event rates to small businesses, such as the North Shore Children's Theater. During the summer, the Lee Mansion garden was a safe meet-up site for Marblehead Parenting, one-on-one music lessons, and group yoga classes. In August, the Museum presented the Great Marblehead Tag and Treasure Sale fundraiser, donating half of the proceeds to the Marblehead Food Pantry.

The Museum Board members kept up the outdoor festivities throughout the fall and winter as well. Highlights of the year included the capacity attendance for the Indigenous Peoples' Day Celebration and a fall festival co-sponsored with Discover Marblehead, where local vendors were able to showcase and sell their unique products and services.

We wrapped up the year with an outdoor version of the Gingerbread Festival and a fantastic new holiday fundraiser, the "Wonderland of Wreaths." This event encouraged budding artists, local retailers and others to design one-of-a-kind wreaths to be auctioned off with all proceeds to benefit the Museum. These works of art were on display at 170 Washington Street for the first two weeks of December. Amy Durbin used social and traditional media to boost the event and highlight the participating designers. The popularity of this new fundraiser combined with a successful annual appeal ensured that the Museum reached its year-end financial goals.

The Museum was also able to spread extra holiday cheer thanks to the generous donations from several Museum patrons. The Lee Mansion was decorated with beautiful garlands, wreaths and lights for the first time in many years. The simple elegance of the illuminated mansion was the perfect symbol of the Museum's efforts to elevate its profile as a hub of the community during a tumultuous year.

While we have been staying close to home, the Museum has been an important place of culture and comfort. Our resiliency is a direct result of to everyone involved in our organization. This dedicated group stretches to board members, docents, office staff, members of the Marblehead Garden Club, and volunteers and beyond. On behalf of the Museum, a heartfelt thanks to everyone helped out during this difficult year.

Although this past year has been one of the most challenging in the Museum's history; it has also been one of the most rewarding. We have strengthened our connection to our beloved town and to each other. We have embodied our mission to preserve, protect and promote Marblehead's past as a means of enriching the present. We have proven that the Marblehead Museum has a solid foundation that is positioned to grow and prosper. Now going forward with the support and guidance of our community, our goal is to enhance our mission so that it continues to benefit our valued supporters for generations to come.


