The Old Hill cemetery, lying along a rocky ridge in the northern part of the town, was originally the churchyard of the first Meeting House, erected in 1638. It is not laid out in avenues or paths, or any formal plan. Apparently the earlier graves were scattered over the hillside wherever the soil was deep enough, and later graves were arranged in rows, as a long row of 18th century headstones may be interrupted by a 17th century stone set at an angle to the rest. More recently, some lots have been filled, graded and enclosed.

Many soldiers of the American Revolution are buried here, including Brigadier-General John Glover and Captain James Mugford. The graves have been marked with S.A.R. markers. Commodore Samuel Tucker Chapter, D.A.R. has honored the memory of the men and women of the Revolutionary War by a bronze tablet set in the face of the ledge, near the crest of the hill.

The cemetery is kept in excellent condition and is a favorite resort of the townspeople. It is also visited by hundreds of tourists every year.

## Notes

### NOTES.

This record has been checked with a similar record made by Henry Blaney for the Marblehead Historical Society in 1902, and with the "Vital Records of Marblehead to 1850" in order to complete inscriptions on stones that were broken, worn off, or below the surface. In such cases the inscription may have dates or ages in brackets, thus - (aged 53 yrs. V.R.) to show the source of information.

(Rev. Sol.) after a name indicates that it is the grave of a soldier of the Revolution and has been marked by the S.A.R. in co-operation with the Marblehead Historical Society.

For the guidance of those who may wish to visit the "Old Hill" to search for the grave of an ancestor, it is necessary to explain that the list, as copied, begins at the southwest corner near the wall which forms the dividing line between the cemetery and the house lots on Pond St., covers all that part to the left of the old driveway (now grass-covered), continues east and north along the slope of the hill to the extreme northeast corner, then back on the other (N.W.) slope to the monuments on the summit of the hill. Ministers' Row is on the high ground back of the pavilion. The oldest stone is on the level ground by Red's Pond.
